Please complete and return this registration form with (or before) your next common fee payment to Collect Associates, 392 River Road, Shelton, CT 06484. **You must fill out and return this form even if you do not own a boat.**

You must immediately report to Collect Associates any changes in your unit's residents' boats residing on SRCA's property.

Failure to accurately complete and return this registration form by the due date may result in imposition of fines and other remedial action in accordance with SRCA's Rules and Regulations and Policies.

BOATS: All boats (including wind surfers and surf boards, which cannot be stored in Unit Owner's shed or Unit) shall be stored on the beach and must be registered with the Property Manager. Only Residents are allowed to store boats. Boats must be elevated at least 18 inches off the ground to prevent unwanted pests. Masts must be tied down and secured to the boats or stored off SRCA Property. Masts are not allowed to be hung or stored in any other Common Areas. This is for insurance liability reasons. Permission to store a boat shall be granted on a first come, first served basis. Boats shall not obstruct Residents' view of or otherwise interfere with Residents' enjoyment of the beach. Boat storage shall be at the boat owner's risk and expense. Boat owners shall ensure that boats are secured during severe inclement weather.
